1 Puppy Training: Let us do the training and repetition for you during our six-week Puppy Program which also includes daycare. Reward operant conditioning methods are used for shaping and modifying behavior. Puppies repeat behaviors that yield good results. It's that simple. But it does take being able to read body language, good technique, superb timing, skilled performance, redirection, as well as calm patience and repetition.

2 Puppy Socializing: Your puppy will go through gradual learning experiences by interacting with and meeting new puppies and people. Sessions of free play supervised by our trained staff will help your puppy learn proper etiquette and dog language. They will learn to play nicely and make

friends and become more comfortable around others.

3 Puppy Activities, Familiarization, and Adventures: Mental activities enrich your puppy's life and boosts their confidence. Frequent gentle handling helps prepare your puppy to enjoy a happy life being more receptive to new everything. We will help your puppy stay safe and have pleasant puppy experiences while learning life is good.

4 Puppy Behavioral Problems: We will solve specific behavior problems by helping your puppy to choose good behaviors over bad behaviors. We will train your dog that preferred behaviors have greater rewards.

Curriculum for Puppy Training, Socializing and Adventures Programs

18-DAY PROGRAM INCLUDES:

In the 18-day program your puppy will be trained to be a well-mannered puppy whom you can be proud to take out in public. Your puppy will understand puppy socializing in a safe group play environment. Your puppy will learn 64 training points; 46 training vocabulary words; 22 activities; and 8 optional adventures. Each puppy will receive a frameable certificate and a Graduation photo.

- Training A - 1 Using Treats as lures: Practice luring your puppy with treats
- Training A - 2 Luring to sit: Touch treat to dog's nose, lure up, praise sit, touch collar, treat last
- Training A - 3 Luring to Recall, Part 1: Take 2-3 step back, lure dog to you
- Training A - 4 Eye-Contact Exercise: Touch treat to dog's nose then bring it to your eyes

- Training A - 12 Tethering Exercise: Tether your dog and walk with them around the house
- Training A - 13 Real-Life Rewards System: Cue your dog to sit for everything
- Training A - 14 Sit: Hand signal, From lure to cue: Increase your dog's response to your hand signal
- Training A - 15 Sit: Withdraw Treats: Withdraw treats slowly by using slot machine technique
- Training A - 16 Recall: Increase Luring Distance, Add Verbal Cue
- Training A - 17 Down: Slide treat towards dog's chest then lure straight down
- Training A - 18 Release: "Go play" or "release"

- Training A - 31 Down: Naming the behavior, puppy pushups
- Training A - 32 Standing Pose: Lure forward so your dog follows the treat to standing position
- Training A - 33 Off and Take It Trades: Phase 2: Practice trades for items of equal or greater value
- Training A - 34 Climbing Stairs: Step and block dog with your leg, reward each step
- Training A - 35 Door Training: cue a sit, then say "off" before you open the door
- Training A - 36 Settle Down: from down-stay position, offer treats one by one
- Training A - 37 Social Manners
- Training A - 38 Sit 1. Lure with treat to sit
- Training A - 39 Sit 2. Hand signal without a treat
- Training A - 40 Sit 3. Sit in public at three random moments

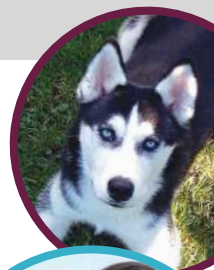

30-DAY PROGRAM INCLUDES:

Our 30-day program prepares your puppy to become an AKC S.T.A.R. Puppy. If parents want the AKC S.T.A.R. Puppy Medal and Certificate, then parent(s) must participate in (6) one-hour Saturday sessions. Happy Pets does not charge extra for Saturday sessions. Your puppy will learn 64 training points PLUS training on 7 common behavioral issues, 15 AKC S.T.A.R. Puppy Requirements, 79 training vocabulary words, 25 activities; and 8 optional adventures.

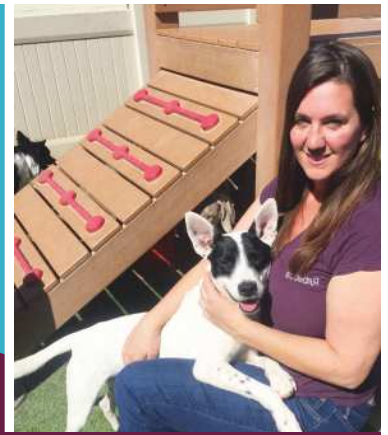

AGE AND VACCINATION REQUIREMENTS

- Puppies can start the program between ages 9-weeks to 5-months of age.
- Vaccination records by a licensed vet for Parvo, Distemper and Bordetella. Must wait 7-days after distemper vaccination is given for puppy's inoculation.
- Rabies due by 4-months of age.
- Licensed vet to provide clean bill of health including parasite free stool sample before first attendance.
- *Please bring your puppy's meals to be served during their visits.*
- *Each puppy will be provided a training log to track and chart progress during the 6-week course.*

HOW TO GET STARTED

Decide which package and level of time is perfect for you and your puppy. The 18-day package includes everything needed for the basics+. The 24-day package addresses chewing, biting, barking, phobia, and other behavioral problems in more depth. The 30-day includes prep work for AKC's Canine Good Citizen S.T.A.R. Puppy's twenty essential skills.
